Thai cuisine is defined by the balance of heat, herbs, and acidity.
Our wines are therefore curated by how their structure meets these flavors on the palate.

A simple way to begin:

Spicy or Chili-Forward

Look to **The Heat Tamers**. Off-dry Rieslings and aromatic whites soften chili heat while lifting notes of lemongrass and makrut lime.

Fried, Seafood, or Citrus-Driven

Explore **Salinity & Spark** or **The Coastal Wind**. Champagne, Grüner Veltliner, and other crisp whites refresh the palate and highlight the freshness of the ingredients.

Rich or Coconut-Based

Turn to **Texture & Uplift**. These fuller, elegant whites balance creamy coconut sauces without being overwhelmed by spice.

Prefer Red Wine?

Discover **Umami & the Forest Floor**. These reds are selected for their softer tannins and savory depth, allowing them to complement chili and fermented flavors rather than clash with them.

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CHAPTER IV: THE HEAT TAMERS (RIESLING & AROMATICS)

The pinnacle of spicy food pairing. Brilliant acidity and a touch of residual sugar act as a cooling counterpoint to chili heat, while lifting the aromatics of lemongrass, galangal, and makrut lime leaf.
